Registration Information
Registration for Summer programs will begin Wednesday, June 12th. All program participants are expected to become members of the Centre and to pay the advertised fee for each program. Participants will be asked to show their 2013 full-time membership cards. Guests can attend programs twice before becoming a full-time member (program fees apply). Registration and fee payments (cash or cheque) for day programs are accepted in the Centre during public operating hours. The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel or alter advertised programs, instructors, special events and travel schedules. Full refunds are issued if the Centre is responsible for a cancelled day program. Withdrawal Request Forms are available at the Administration Office, and must be submitted before the third class of a day program commences to be eligible for a refund. Refunds will be pro-rated and will include a $\$ 5.00$ administration fee for each program. NSF cheques: $\$ 25.00$ fee applies. This policy applies to Centre managed programs only.

## Program Cancellations

Our programs can only run as long as we have a minimum number of participants registered in them. Therefore, it is very important to register for programs at least a week before the program starts.
