REGISTRATION The club executive retains the right to approve or revoke membership of all players by majority vote. New members are welcome.

EQUIPMENT The club has 9 tables at the Mississauga Chinese Presbyterian Church and 14 tables at the Woodlands Secondary school. Due to the step up to the gym floor at the school, tables should be taken from storage by two people. Members must bring their own bats and balls. Running shoes must be worn. Proper table tennis attire is dark, solid colour clothing. Members may buy tournament quality balls for use at the club at a competitive price.

ACTIVITIES Practice is rotated to encourage balanced matches with graduated standard of play. Practice may be limited to 30 minutes and controlled using a scheduling board if attendance is heavy. Other activities such as the Mississauga Table Tennis League are to be determined. It may run from the end of October to April and club members could join one of the teams at the beginning of the season. We may run winter and spring Tournaments for club members that would be included in member's fees. A banquet may be organized at the end of the season at a reasonable extra cost.

SCHOOL AND CHURCH RULES: **NO SMOKING** is allowed. **NO FOOD AND DRINKS (except water) may be consumed in the church or school.** We must enter the school through the south door. We are permitted access to the gym, the storage room, the men's, and ladies' changing rooms and washrooms, the adjacent hallways and the telephone. There is always a caretaker in the school who is responsible for unlocking the rooms we use and for security. Play must stop at the church and school by 9:45 pm., and all members must be out at 10:00 pm.

GENERAL Members are expected to help in setting up and removing the tables, nets and dividers, etc. We are responsible for keeping the space we use tidy, so please put litter in the containers provided. The church and school are used by other groups and members are advised not to leave money or other valuables unattended.
